**Re: Out of Hours Works for Light Rail within the Gungahlin & Alinga Termini**

From 17 January 2022, for three (3) nights, Canberra Metro Operations (CMET) will be undertaking essential maintenance works on the light rail tracks at both the Alinga and Gungahlin Termini. This work will occur from 12am to 5am nightly. **There will be no impact to light rail services.**

**What to expect**

The maintenance work includes:

- Grinding of track point/switch machines.
- The equipment and plant to be used may include light vehicles, light towers and a rail point/switch grinding machine. Due to the nature of the work, some of the activities will be noisy.
- The maintenance team will limit these impacts wherever possible by reducing the number of machines operating at the same time and turning off equipment when not in use.

**Traffic and Pedestrian impacts**

There will be no impact to traffic or pedestrian access through intersections.


**Out of hours work**

The work is required to be undertaken out of hours to allow access to the point/switch machines to grind the rail into the required profile, ensuring ongoing operation of the light rail network, without impacting passenger services.
