**Re: Out of Hours Works for Light Rail within the Harrison and Franklin areas**

Over the next five months Canberra Metro Operations (CMET) will be undertaking essential training works for one week each month on the light rail tracks on Flemington Road between Well Station Drive and Nullarbor Avenue. The first training will occur from 12am to 5am nightly from Sunday 1 August to Friday 6 August 2021. **There will be no impact to light rail services.**

**What to expect**

The training includes:

- Towing of a light rail vehicle along the light rail tracks;
- Ringing of bells and horns, similar to those heard normally on the light rail vehicles;
- Workers on the track between Wells Station Drive stop to Nullarbor Avenue stop; and
- Engine noise and amber flashing lights from the 'Unimog' towing vehicle.

**Traffic and Pedestrian impacts**

There will be no impact to traffic or pedestrian access through intersections, with training observing all traffic and rail signals.


**Out of hours work**
